VISAS:

Important for all players who need visa to Canada:

Please request immediately from Badminton Canada an official Invitation Letter and apply as soon as possible. In order to issue the invitation, you must complete the 2019 Pan Am JR Championship Visa Application Form. Please send the form to the email address below.

Electronic Travel Authority (eTA): If you DO NOT need a VISA to come to Canada, you will need an eTA. eTAs can be secured upon the purchase of your flight or by going to the following website <https://bit.ly/2zLhLcU>.

VISA/eTA exemption: Citizens of the USA who are travelling to Canada on their USA passport do not require an eTA or VISA to enter Canada.

Transportation:

Badminton Canada will offer transportation from the airport to the official Hotel, and venue, **only when booking reservations** with the official **Booking Form** for the Official Hotels.

Uniforms:

According **BPAC** regulations, for all tournaments the player's name and the country on the back of the shirt is mandatory. (BWF GCR, refereeing player's clothing, designs, advertising and lettering).

Take note that the name of the payer on the back of the shirt must comply with the name registered on BWF – player's data base.
