

Seeding Procedure for XXVIII Pan Am Junior Championships 2019

Individual Events from U11 to U17

- 1. BPAC is responsible for the Pan Am Junior Championships, as the Continental body for our sport. As such, these Regulations for seeding are to be followed.
- 2. Categories and age groups:
 - a. U11 Born between 2009 2010
 - b. U13 Born between 2007 2008
 - c. U15 Born between 2005 2006
 - d. U17 Born between 2003 2004
- 3. Seeding will be send to the Referee before published on July 5th, 2019 MAs will have 4 days (until July 9th, 2019) to make observations. After this period no alterations will be made to the seeding, all draws will made during the Team Managers Meeting on Monday 15th, July 2019.
- 4. Seeding for individual events will take in consideration the following:
 - a. Only 4 seeds per event.
 - b. Top 4 players/pairs from last Pan Am Junior will get priority for seeding if they repeat their age group.
 - c. If after this procedure there are still places open for Seeding, then the top 4 players/pairs from the lower age group that change category could be seeded. Priority will be given to the winner, then runner-up, then semi-finalists (if only one place available then by lot will be decided who gets the available place).
 - d. If after these steps, there are still places available for seeding, then the country for which a player/pair in that age group would have been seeded, then the representative from the same country will tall take the place.
