The test must be in English, Spanish or Portuguese.</li> <li>Passengers should fill the Traveler's Health Declaration before arrival: https://formulario.anvisa.gov.br/?lang=en</li> <li>Countries under travel restrictions (from 17 May 2021):</li> <li>Passengers who in the past 14 days have been in or transited through India, South Africa or United Kingdom are not allowed to enter or transit through Brazil.</li> <li>All participants must take the Covid Antigeno test as soon as they arrive at the hotel free of charge for international players. This to ensure that participants enter the tournament are COVID-19 free.</li> </ol>
