

This activity was created to maintain contact with all BPAC TOs and National Technical Official Coordinators as well.


Ten meeting were delivered between the months of May and July 2020.

Badminton Pan Am Home Cup 2020




This virtual competition was created for **Players** and **Fans** which due to the pandemic must remain at home.


Considering this, BPAC brought to Players' home a very especial badminton competition in which they face several challenges against other player from a different country through four seasons.



• BPAC Events Workshop 2020




This activity is focused BPAC Member Associations, giving them the introduction and grass roots about Events management.


As a main goal in this activity is to encourage participation Member Associations to create projects that could be delivered in the future, considering all the requirements for an Event that at the end meets all the expectations.





Tournament Protocols

Considering the Pandemic, new tournament procedures "Protocols" were implemented by BWF and adopted by each Member Association to back to Competition, ensuring the safety of all the participants (Players, Technical Officials, Tournament Staff and other personal involved into the competition).

Following this, all Members Association which host an International Tournament must attach Tournament Covid protocols together with the tournament prospectus.

As well the **Continental Events Protocols** were tailored according with the special needs of each continental event and host country as follow:

- Tournament Bubble.
- PCR Covid Negative Test 72 hours before to the beginning of the tournament.
- Control Covid Test before and during the tournament.
- Area's designation into the competition venue. (Green and Red zones)
- Accreditations with special features.

After implementing protocols, we have had only two positive cases which were dealt with NF accordingly and isolated in both cases.

In the way to improve **Tournament Calendar Delivery**, during 2021 BPAC Events Area have ran an NPS Survey during each continental event.

Identify pain points into the delivery of each event along all areas involved, have help BPAC Area to focus on specific issues that are relevant for the wellbeing of all tournament participants.

COVID-19 safety perception of the participants is a **recurrent** comment into the survey, which implicates that the implementation of the protocols is well accepted and follow despite some restrictions which must be enforced.

TOs Training



As a result of the Talking About Rules activity delivered during 2020, and in line with outcome to improve Umpire Skills to have better prepared Umpire for BWF Accreditation assessments, the BPAC Umpire Skills Building programme was created.

BPAC Umpires interested to be part of the programme applied submitting several

documents and meeting requirements which were mandatories to be considered by the Assessors Panel.

10 Umpires of 20 Candidates were selected to be part of this **first group** of outstanding **Technical Officials** in an acceptance procedure which last from February to May 2021.

2 monthly sessions of 5 have been delivered up to date, between sessions all attendees must solve a task which must be presented a week before to the next session.

All **four continental regions** have at least one representative at this activity with the following countries: ARG, BRA, CAN, ESA, MEX.
