#### **Eligible Players:**

**U19:** players who are U19 years of age through the year 2022 (i.e. born on 2004 or younger) and who are eligible to represent for BWF Member Associations are allowed to play, **BPAC** require player's passports to confirm the age and nationality.

\*Players passports will be required at the end of the Team Managers Meeting\*

#### **Entry limits & Competition system:**

A Main Draw of 64 for singles and doubles.

Each Member Association can enter the following number of players/pairs per event:

Singles (BS/GS) A maximum of four (4) players per event.
 Doubles (BD/GD) A maximum of two (2) pairs per event.

• Mixed Doubles A maximum of four (4) pairs.

According with BPAC Regulations, the **Host Member Association** can enter the following number of players/pairs per event:

Singles (BS/GS) A maximum of six (6) players per event.
 Doubles (BD/GD) A maximum of three (3) pairs per event.
 Mixed Doubles A maximum of six (6) pairs per event.

#### Visas

Important for all players who need visa to Dominican Republic:

Please request immediately from Dominican Badminton Federation an official letter and apply as soon as possible. In order to issue the invitation, you must complete the 2022 Pan Am Junior Championship Visa application form. Please send the form to the email address below.

#### **Transportation:**

**Dominican Badminton Federation** will provide **mandatory** transportation from the airport to the official hotels, and daily to tournament venue, for players, team members and parents with **mandatory** registered through the Organizing Committee. Otherwise, player will not be allowed to play in the tournament because of COVID19 bubble health protocols.

Considering Covid-19 protocols all participants (Player, team members, TOs, national and international staff, must take official, transportations)

## **Uniforms:**

According **BPAC** regulations, for all tournaments the player's name and country name on the back of the shirt is mandatory. (Statutes, Section 5.1 GCR 20-24, referring player's clothing, designs advertising and lettering).







Take note that the name of the player on the back of the shirt must comply with the name registered on BWF – player's data base.

#### Covid- 19 Protocols:

The cost of the antigen tests for the detection of COVID-19 will be US\$40 dollars while the PCR tests cost will be US\$90 dollars.

All participants, players, coaches, managers, Technical Officials and other tournament staff, must present a PCR COVID-19 test (negative result) within the last three days before to the beginning of the competition (Team Managers Meeting)

With this we can ensure that all participants at the beginning of the tournament are COVID19 free with a certain security.

Requirements to enter to Dominican Republic: It is recommended that all Tournament participants (Players, Coaches, Managers, TOs and others which are coming from abroad Travel by air, so in this way the access to the country will be less complicated, considering that control and overall sanitary measures are similar than the ones which are established in most countries, like the mandatory use of facemask, social distancing of 1.5 mts, wash hands constantly while the travel, the use of antibacterial gel and do not touch the face.

In overall you must follow up strictly all guidelines established by the aviation authorities and airline as well.

Once you are out of the airport, a representative of the Organizing Committee will give you the indications to take the transportation shuttle to the hotel, one of the indications to consider are:

- All luggage will be disinfected prior to going into the vehicle
- All passengers must be aware of their personal belongings at every time and must put their luggage in the transportation vehicle.
- Your luggage under any circumstances will be handled by third person (driver or assistant)
- Before going into the bus, you will receive antibacterial gel and must sit on specific marked chairs.

#### Anti - Doping:

Anti-doping will be conducted in accordance with BWF and WADA regulations. Please consult the BWF website for further information, and to view the current WADA Prohibited List. Please note that athletes must complete a TUE application process to apply for authorization to take medications which fall under the Prohibited List – before they take medication.

#### **Doping control**

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

#### **Badminton Integrity**

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course of result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.
