Countries such as the United States and Canada must do so one month in advance of the established date of the tournament

Airport:

International Airport of “Maiquetia” Simon Bolivar (CCS) in La Guaira State, is the main point of arrival.

Transportation:

The Venezuelan Badminton Federation will provide transportation service from the airport to the official hotels and headquarters, for players and team members registered through the Organizing Committee with an additional cost of \$40 per person, taking into account that the distance from the airport to the Official Hotel is 1 hour and 30 minutes.

If you do not want the service, transportation lines registered at the airport are recommended.

Uniforms:

The player’s name on the back of the shirts and the name of the country are mandatory and must be in accordance with the following specific literals of the BWF Statutes, Section 5.1: General Competition Regulations – From Lit 20. Player Clothing and Equipment. to Lit 24.5. Badminton Pan Am Tournament Circuit, section 18: Uniforms.

Medical:

Medical support will be available at the venue

Doping control:

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes medication, they should check with the doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

Integrity:

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.
