 - ❖ GUA (April 1–7, 2024): 5 coaches trained under Martijn Van Dooremalen (NED) guidelines, focusing on elite coaching techniques.
 - ❖ MEX (Post XXII Pan Am Jr. Championship 2024): 9 coaches trained under Eva Lee (USA) & Martin Trejo (ARG), BWF CE3 alumnus leadership, strengthening youth coaching.
 - ❖ PER (October 8 to 15, 2024), outstanding coaches from our region took part and learned specific badminton techniques from head coaches Martijn Van Dooremalen (NED) and Wojciech Szkudlarczyk (POL), considering specific approaches in the game of Singles and Doubles.
