For late withdrawal, the withdrawal notification must include the reason for withdrawal takes place after the draw is made, it must be supported by medical certificate.

If the withdrawal arises after your player arrives in Peru, notification of withdrawal must be made by the Team Manager in person to the Referee, or Deputy, and must be confirmed in writing.

Official Coaches:

As per BPAC regulations, each participant Member Association must appoint an official Coach or Coaches (maximum of two) for continental event (Team Continental / Individual). If the participating Member Association chooses to not appoint an official coach, the participating Member Association must send an official letter to BPAC appointing a maximum of two of its participant players as coaches plus one as a Team Manager.

“ Only Players appointed as Team Managers or Coaches by their Members Association, must fulfil all the regulations contained in [BWF Statutes Section 2.2.6 Coaches and Educators Code of Conduct](#)” and [BWF Statutes, Section 5.1: GENERAL COMPETITION REGULATIONS: . PLAYER AND COACH CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT](#)

12. Official Coaches

12.1 Each Member Association must designate an official Coach or Coaches (maximum two) for the Continental Championship Events described herein, except for the Junior Pan American Championships that each Member Association may appoint one coach for every 8 players registered in the tournament.

12.2 Official coaches must have at least BWF Coach Level 1.

12.3. If the Member Association decides not to appoint an official coach, then the Member Association may send an official letter to BPAC and the Local Organizing Committee appointing one or maximum two of its participating players as coaches for the specific Tournament (except for the Junior Pan American Championships).

12.3.1. Players appointed as coaches by their Member Association must comply with all regulations contained in the [“BWF “Code of Conduct for Coaches and Educators”](#).

12.3.2. Only players appointed as coaches by their Member Association for a particular Continental Championship may be on the field of play in the role of coach.

Member Associations are allowed to request representation by another Member Association, provided that the Tournament Referee is notified in advance and approves.

It is compulsory for the Member Association's Team Manager and or Representative attend the Team Managers Meeting. Failing to attend the meeting, would mean the Member Association is liable to be fined as per BWF Regulations.

Anti-doping:

Anti-doping will be conducted in accordance with BWF and WADA regulations. Please consult the BWF website for further information, and to view the current WADA Prohibited List. Please note that athletes must complete a TUE application process to apply for authorization to take medications which fall under the Prohibited List – before they take medication.

Doping control

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).
