Team Manager	Each participant Member Association must appoint a Team Manager.
Insurance Coverage	Players and all members of the national delegation shall hold valid insurance for damages of any nature caused to third parties. Such insurance shall cover bodily injury, medical and hospitalization expenses incurred in the host country, and all expenses and costs associated with repatriating the injured/ill party to its country of residence. Please check to make sure you have adequate insurance in place.
Indemnity	To the extent permitted by applicable law, all players and members of the national delegation shall release the BWF, the local partner and their respective officers, officials, employees, agents, and representatives from any and all liability, damage, loss, cost, or expense that such players and members of the national delegation may incur as a result or in connection with their participation to the tournament.

2. Entry Details

Entry Fee	No entry fees will be charged to participating Teams.
Entry Deadlines	1 st April 2026 (18.00h Lima) - presentation of the preliminary list of team players. 10 th April 2026 - submission of the final list of team players at the Team Managers Meeting
Preliminary List of Players	Countries are allowed to submit a preliminary list of 6 players per gender, from which three or four players will be chosen to participate in the tournament.
Allowed Final Entries per Country	Male Players: minimum 3 and maximum 4. Female Players: minimum 3 and maximum 4.
Entry Process	Member Associations must complete the Team Entry Form and return it to events@badmintonpanam.org rsalamanca@badmintonpanam.org
Eligibility	Participation in this open to all Member Associations affiliated with Badminton Pan Am and in accordance with BWF General Competition Regulations - Section 6: International Representation.
Mixed Team Relay Draw	Friday, April 10 th , 2026.

Practice Sessions	Practice will be available at the competition venue on Friday, 10 th April

Clothing and Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The AirShuttles used during the AirBadminton Competition will be supplied by the BWF. - The athletes' clothing consists of shorts and shirts. - The Referee may authorize an athlete to play with compression pants or sleeves. - Athletes must play barefoot; however, the Referee may authorize an athlete to play with shoes and/or socks in special circumstances. - Players may wear a hat/head covering, glasses or lenses at their own risk. - Clothing and equipment used by athletes and other participants in the event must comply with the documents listed below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> □ BWF Laws of Badminton - Section 4. □ BWF General Competition Regulations - Sections 20 to 24.
Presentation Ceremony	All prize ceremonies will take place on Saturday 11 th April 2026, immediately after the conclusion of each final. Medals/trophies/others will be presented to all champions and finalists.
Participation support	BPAC will provide a financial support of USD \$350 to all Member Associations participating in this competition. Please note that this support is intended exclusively to cover accommodation expenses .
AirShuttles	AirShuttles will be provided during practice sessions and the competition.
Medical Services	A medical officer will be available throughout the tournament during hours of play, free of charge to players.
Live Streaming	Live streaming service is being coordinated with the local partner - information will be provided during the Team Managers Briefing.
