Players and all members of the national delegation will assume all expenses related to injuries, medical treatment, or hospitalization, and must ensure that their players and officials are in good health and have adequate insurance. The Tournament Organizer is not liable for any claims, damages, or losses arising from participation in or cancellation of the tournament.

Participant Agreement for Use of Photographs and Videos

Players and all members of the national delegation shall agree to give the BWF and the Tournament Organizer full television and motion picture rights, including permission to film players and members of the national delegation during all matches and activities around the Tournament, for any commercial, news or other purpose together with the right to transfer such right, including without compensation.

2. Entry Details

Regulations (Conditions of Play)

This tournament will be run in accordance with, but not limited to, the Badminton World Federation (BWF) Statutes, General Competition Regulations (GCR), General Competition Regulations (GCR), Badminton Pan Am Regulation (BPAC) and CC Grade 3 Tournament Regulations. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final.

Clothing Regulation

For all tournaments included in the Pan American Badminton Circuit, the name of the player on the back of the jerseys and the name of the country are mandatory and must be in accordance with the BWF GCR regulations. This tournament will strictly enforce the Clothing, Equipment, and Advertising Regulations as outlined in BWF GCR 20–24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to the BWF

It is mandatory that for all tournaments that are part of the Continental Tour all opposing players wear different colours significant for the quarterfinals, semifinals and finals (BWF GCR: 21. COLOUR OF PLAYERS' CLOTHING, 21.6).

Scoring System

Best of three games to 21 points, according to the Laws of Badminton (Statute 4.1 of the BWF).

Please see the key dates section for entry deadline. Late entries will not be accepted. For this tournament, the entry deadline is **Tuesday, April 7th, 2026 at 11:59 PM (GMT +08:00)**.

Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by **Wednesday, one day after the entry deadline at 23:59 hrs. BWF Headquarters time**.

If no objection is received by BWF, **Friday two days after entry deadline at 23:59 hrs. BWF Headquarters time**, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections will be entertained after this point.

Entry Fees

Entry Fees for international players will be as follows:

- \$120 USD per player (No event)

All payments must be made before the start of the competition, in cash only, using banknotes in good condition.

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The event registration fee is payable in cash only before the start of the tournament. Failure to pay the registration fee according to the regulations will result in the affected players being ineligible to participate. The member association that registers a player for a tournament on the circuit is responsible for paying that player's registration fee.

The registration fee must be paid at the technical conference or before your match. Failure to pay the registration fee will result in ineligibility to participate.

Withdrawals

The management of withdrawals will be run in accordance with BWF GCR 13 and 14.

Member Associations can withdraw their entries through the BWF Online Group Entry system until the last date of withdrawal without penalty. **Monday, April 27, 2026 at 11:59 PM (GMT +08:00).**

Withdrawals made after this date will incur a penalty in accordance with the BWF Table of Offences and Penalties (BWF Statute 2.5).

Please ensure that the Tournament Referee and Host Organizer are notified immediately in writing, clearly stating the reason for the withdrawal.

If a Member Association needs to withdraw any entries once players have arrived in the host city, notification of withdrawal must be made by the Team Manager in person to the Tournament Referee, or Deputy Referee(s), and must also be confirmed in writing to:

Presentation Ceremonies

All prize ceremonies will take place on Sunday (last day of the tournament), **Sunday, May 10, 2026**, immediately after the conclusion of each final. Medals/trophies/other will be presented to all champions and finalists.

In accordance with Player Commitment Regulations (BWF Statue 5.3.6), all players participating in the finals of a tournament must attend the final ceremonies directly after the match or must follow the instructions given by the organizers regarding ceremony protocol.

No equipment, including rackets and flags, are allowed to be brought onto the podium. Clothing worn during the ceremony must be in accordance with the BWF GCR.

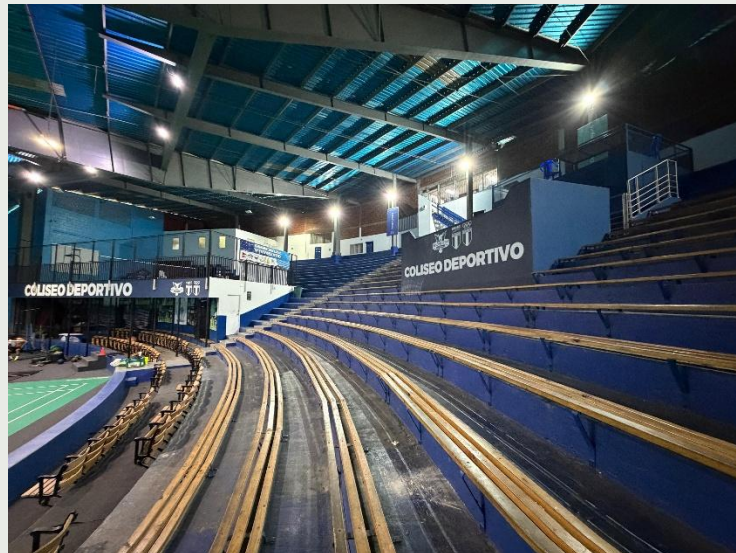

Any visa support letter issued by the tournament host does not guarantee entry into Guatemala; the final decision is made the Government of Guatemala.
