Eligibility	<p>Age Eligibility: Each player must be under 19 years of age throughout the calendar year in which the tournament is held (2026). Participation in this Continental AirBadminton Junior is open to all Member Associations affiliated with Badminton Pan Am.</p>

Regulation for Triples	<p>The format of the Triples Competition will be according to the BWF Statutes 4.2 - Rules of AirBadminton (Nov 2024)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Matches will consist of the best of five games with each game won by the first side to score 9 points, and in case of 8-all, by the side with a two-point lead, in case of 12-all the first side which scores the next point (13th).
Practice Sessions	<p>Practice will be available at the competition venue on Sunday, July 26th</p>
Clothing and Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The AirShuttles used during the AirBadminton Competition will be supplied by the BWF. - The athletes' clothing consists of shorts and shirts. - The Referee may authorize an athlete to play with compression pants or sleeves. - Athletes must play barefoot; however, the Referee may authorize an athlete to play with shoes and/or socks in special circumstances. - Players may wear a hat/head covering, glasses or lenses at their own risk. - Clothing and equipment used by athletes and other participants in the event must comply with the documents listed below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> □ BWF Laws of Badminton - Section 4. □ BWF General Competition Regulations - Sections 20 to 24.
Presentation Ceremony	<p>All prize ceremonies will take place on Monday, July 27th, immediately after the conclusion of each final. Medals/trophies/others will be presented to all champions and finalists.</p>
AirShuttles	<p>AirShuttles will be provided during practice sessions and the competition.</p>
Medical Services	<p>A medical officer will be available throughout the tournament during hours of play, free of charge to players.</p>
Live Streaming	<p>Live streaming service is being coordinated with the local partner - information will be provided during the Team Managers Briefing.</p>
Official Hotels	<p>The list of official hotels will be provided later, after visiting the recommended locations.</p>
