According to the quota established by Panam Sports, there will be a maximum total number of ninety (90) male and female athletes in the Badminton competition; forty-five (45) women and forty-five (45) men.

Each NOC may register a maximum of four (4) men and four (4) women to participate, provided that each of them has qualified in accordance with the BWF and BPAC requirements.

\*An exception will be made in case that the athletes qualified at the II Junior Pan American Games ASU 2025 are from countries that have already qualified four (4) men and four (4) women according to the ranking qualification process. In this case, the NOC can enter the MI or WI champion of the ASU 2025 Games.

Each NOC may register three (3) players for the Singles events and two (2) couples for the Doubles events.

## Athlete eligibility

Athletes must have signed and submitted the athlete eligibility conditions form.

All participating athletes must be at least 14 years old; that is, athletes born in 2013 or before.

Each NOC who is an associated member of BWF and BPAC will be entitled to participate with a minimum of one (1) player in the Badminton competition of the XX Pan American Games Lima 2027.

## ASU 2025 quotas

Panam Sports gives to all gold medalists in individual events, of both Men's Singles and Women's Singles, a direct quota for the Lima 2027 Pan American Games, which will not be part of the maximum quota specified in the qualification process for these Games.

### Terms and conditions of direct quotas:

#### Personal title

1. The quota granted by Panam Sports is personal and non-transferable, in view of the fact that it belongs exclusively to the gold medalist.
2. The quota granted by Panam Sports may not be allocated to another athlete from the same country, nor to the silver medalist of the competition, in the event that the gold medalist cannot participate.

#### Commitment to participate

1. To keep the direct quota granted by Panam Sports, the benefited athletes must meet the following requirements:
  - A minimum of two (2) participations in international championships with World Ranking Points of the Pan American circuit within the period of August 1, 2025, to July 31, 2026.
  - A minimum of two (2) participations in international championships with World Ranking Points of the Pan American circuit within the period of August 1, 2026, to April 30, 2027.

#### Loss of direct quota

1. By rejection of the NOC to the quota granted by Panam Sports.
2. Due to inability to participate by the athlete, because of injury.
3. For not complying with the participation commitment criteria.

## Qualification system

The BPAC Executive Committee has approved the following procedure for the allocation of spots among BPAC affiliated members. The initial allocation will be as follows:

- a) The country rankings are determined by adding up the highest points of each country's top-ranked player or team in the Men's Singles, Women's Singles, Men's Doubles, Women's Doubles, and Mixed Doubles events (for a maximum total of five rankings) using the BWF World Rankings for 2027 as of April 20 (Week #16). The higher the total number of points, the higher the country's ranking.
- b) The quota belongs to the country and not to the individual athlete. Each NOC may develop its own procedure for selecting its competitor(s) to participate in the Badminton Competition. To qualify, each competitor must also be eligible to participate in the XX Pan American Games Lima 2027.

- c) Depending on the number of countries that actually register players for the XX Pan American Games, the BPAC reserves the right to adjust participation levels upward (when there are fewer than forty-four (44) entries per gender in the initial allocation) or downward (when there are more than forty-four (44) entries per gender in the initial allocation) to meet the athlete quota; that is, forty-four (44) men and forty-four (44) women.

## Confirmation of quotas

On April 20, 2027 (week #16), BPAC will confirm to Panam Sports and to the NOCs the quotas obtained.

Before April 21, 2027 (week #16), the NOCs will confirm to Panam Sports and to BPAC the quotas they will use.

## Reallocation of unused quota places

In case that the quota of forty-four (44) men and forty-four (44) women is not filled in the initial allocation, the additional spots will be allocated as follows.

Starting with the 4th-ranked country (three (3) or fewer entries), each ranked country, in order of ranking, may enter one (1) additional male and/or female athlete until the full quota is completed or all countries and additional athletes have been offered a spot, whichever comes first. If the quota is not yet completed, then the process will be repeated until it is completed, with each country limited to four (4) men's spots and four (4) women's spots.

The following dates will apply for this procedure:

- a) On April 21 (week #16) Panam Sports will inform BPAC the number of spots that must be reallocated.
- b) On April 21 (week #16) BPAC will inform to Panam Sports and to the NFs the new allocated spots for the event.
- c) On April 21 (week #16) Panam Sports will inform the NOCs the new allocated spots for the event.
- d) On April 22 (week #16) the NOCs will inform Panam Sports if they accept the new spots for their country.
- e) On July 7 (week #27) Panam Sports will inform BPAC the new list of spots for each NOC for the event.
- f) On July 9 (week #27) Panam Sports will publish the final list on its official website.

## Competition draw

The draws will be conducted according to the BWF General Competition Regulations, as outlined in the BWF Statutes. The draw will be made at the BWF offices (July 27, 2027).

Seeds will be based on the BWF World Ranking (July 27, 2027).

## Qualification for the Los Angeles 2028 Olympic Games

In Badminton, athletes will be able to obtain points for the BWF World Ranking that will be used for Olympic Qualification.
