2. Entry Details

Regulations (Conditions of Play) Cloting Regulation	This tournament will be run in accordance with, but not limited to, the Badminton World Federation (BWF) Statutes, General Competition Regulations (GCR), General Competition Regulations (GCR), Badminton Pan Am Regulation (BPAC) and CC Grade 3 Tournament Regulations. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final. For all tournaments included in the Pan American Badminton Circuit, the name of the player on the back of the jerseys and the name of the country are mandatory and must be in accordance with the BWF GCR regulations. This tournament will strictly enforce the Clothing, Equipment, and Advertising Regulations as outlined in BWF GCR 20–24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to the BWF It is mandatory that for all tournaments that are part of the Continental Tour all opposing players wear different colours significant for the quarterfinals, semifinals and finals (BWF GCR: 21. COLOUR OF PLAYERS' CLOTHING, 21.6).

	No equipment, including rackets and flags, are allowed to be brought onto the podium. Clothing worn during the ceremony must be in accordance with the BWF GCR.

Medical Services	A medical officer and physiotherapist service will be available during the tournament, free of charge to players.
Anti-Doping	Anti-Doping will be conducted in accordance with the BWF and WADA regulations. Please consult the BWF website for further information, and to view the current WADA Prohibited list. Please note that the athletes must complete a TUE application process to apply for authorization to take medications which fall under the Prohibited List – before they take medication.
Doping Control	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). Visas	If a visa is required to enter PERU, we only can provide a letter of invitation to assist with your application. All delegations requiring visa support must mandatorily submit the required documentation to the Peruvian Badminton Federation by email to secretaria@badmintonperu.com with copy to eventos@badmintonperu.com. Please note that the Peruvian Badminton Federation does not process or issue visas. The Federation will only receive the required documents and submit them to the Instituto Peruano del Deporte – IPD, so that the IPD may evaluate the request and, if applicable, issue the official invitation letter for the tournament. This invitation letter may be used by the applicant as a supporting document to help facilitate their visa application process before the corresponding Peruvian Consulate or competent authority. The following documents must be submitted: 1. Background and profile of the foreign citizen, including information about their personal and professional career, sports experience, academic background, achievements, positions held, and any other relevant information that supports their participation in the event. 2. Official designation of the foreign citizen as a member of their country's delegation, issued by the governing entity of the corresponding sport in their country of origin or residence, duly apostilled or legalized by the competent Peruvian Consulate, if applicable. 3. Document issued by the competent authority certifying that the foreign citizen has no judicial, criminal, or police records in their country of origin or in any country where they have resided during the five (5) years prior to entering Peruvian territory, duly apostilled or legalized. 4. Copy of the passport with a minimum validity of six (6) months. Incomplete documentation or submissions sent to a different email address may delay the process.

Delegations are strongly encouraged to send all documents as soon as possible in order to allow sufficient time for review and submission to the IPD.

The tournament host and hosting Member Association will only communicate with a Member Association, and the hosting Member Association will only provide a visa support letter if the form is completed accurately and comprehensively, and supporting documentation is provided, where requested.

The tournament host and hosting Member Association accepts no responsibility for withdrawals made due to late or refused visa applications.

It is the responsibility of the Member Association to apply for the necessary visas in sufficient time, and all matters should be directed to the Embassy in charge.

Any visa support letter issued by the tournament host does not guarantee entry into PERU; the final decision is made the Government of PERU.
