Regulations (Conditions of Play) Cloting Regulation	This tournament will be run in accordance with, but not limited to, the Badminton World Federation (BWF) Statutes, General Competition Regulations (GCR), General Competition Regulations (GCR), Badminton Pan Am Regulation (BPAC) and CC Grade 3 Tournament Regulations. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final. For all tournaments included in the Pan American Badminton Circuit, the name of the player on the back of the jerseys and the name of the country are mandatory and must be in accordance with the following specific literals of the This tournament will strictly enforce the Clothing, Equipment, and Advertising Regulations as outlined in the BWF GCR 20 – 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to BWF. It is mandatory that for all tournaments that are part of the Continental Tour all opposing players wear different colours significant for the quarterfinals, semifinals and finals (BWF GCR: 21. COLOUR OF PLAYERS' CLOTHING, 21.6).

Anti-Doping	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE). Visas	Participants who require a visa to enter Peru must submit the following documents so that the Organizing Committee can issue an official invitation letter and forward the visa support request to the Peruvian Sports Institute (IPD), which will subsequently channel the request through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Peru: 1. A clear and legible scanned copy of the participant's valid passport. 2. A copy of the participant's confirmed inbound and outbound flight tickets or travel itinerary. 3. The athlete's résumé/CV, including relevant sporting information and achievements. 4. Participants residing in a country other than their country of nationality must also provide a copy of their valid residence permit or foreign resident identification card. The complete request and all required supporting documents must be submitted to the Organizing Committee at least thirty (30) business days before the official start date of the tournament. A separate email must be submitted for each athlete. Only emails containing the complete information and all required documents for the respective athlete will be accepted and processed. Visas for athletes who participate in preceding tournaments	Athletes who plan to participate in another tournament or undertake international travel before attending this event in Peru must clearly inform the Organizing Committee when submitting their visa support request. The email must include the name, host country and official dates of the preceding tournament, as well as the athlete's complete travel itinerary and intended date of entry into Peru. In such cases, the required submission deadline of thirty (30) business days will be calculated from the official start date of the preceding tournament or the earliest event included in the athlete's travel itinerary, and not from the start date of the tournament in Peru. Requests that do not disclose this information in advance or that are submitted after the applicable deadline may not be processed in time
