2. Entry Details

Regulations (Conditions of Play) Clothing Regulation	This tournament will be run in accordance with, but not limited to, the Badminton World Federation (BWF) Statutes, General Competition Regulations (GCR), General Competition Regulations (GCR), Badminton Pan Am Regulation (BPAC) and CC Grade 3 Tournament Regulations. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final. For all tournaments included in the Pan American Badminton Circuit, the name of the player on the back of the jerseys and the name of the country are mandatory and must be in accordance with the following specific literals of the This tournament will strictly enforce the Clothing, Equipment, and Advertising Regulations as outlined in the BWF GCR 20 – 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to BWF. It is mandatory that for all tournaments that are part of the Continental Tour all opposing players wear different colors significant for the quarterfinals, semifinals and finals (BWF GCR: 21. COLOUR OF PLAYERS' CLOTHING, 21.6).

Entry Fees	Entry Fees for international players will be as follows: • \$180.00 USD per player / All payments must be made prior to the start of competition. Paid in ONLY IN CASH, preferably at the end of Team Managers Meeting. If entry fee is not paid according to the regulation, the players concerned will not be allowed to play. The member association that enters a player into a circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player.
Withdrawals	The management of withdrawals will be run in accordance with BWF GCR 13 and 14. Member Associations can withdraw their entries through the BWF Online Group Entry system until the last date of withdrawal without penalty. Monday, October 19th Withdrawals made after this date will incur a penalty in accordance with the BWF Table of Offences and Penalties (BWF Statute 2.5). Please ensure that the Tournament Referee and Host Organizer are notified immediately in writing, clearly stating the reason for the withdrawal. In accordance with Player Commitment Regulations (BWF Statue 5.3.6), all players participating in the finals of a tournament must attend the final ceremonies directly after the match or must follow the instructions given by the organizers regarding ceremony protocol. No equipment, including rackets and flags, are allowed to be brought onto the podium. Clothing worn during the ceremony must be in accordance with the BWF GCR.

Accreditation	Access to Tournament venues and other services are provided through personalized and photographic accreditation. Please fill the accreditation form (<i>Provided at Badminton-PANAM / BWF websites</i>) and send it before Oct 23th to ady_menap@hotmail.com The fee to replace any lost or damaged accreditation passes will be USD\$100 on each occasion, and must be paid ONLY IN CASH. The fraudulent use of accreditation is strictly prohibited, and will result in access rights being removed, and penalties being applied.
Medical Services	A medical officer and physiotherapist service will be available during the tournament, free of charge to players. Each player is responsible for having medical expense insurance.
Anti-Doping	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out- of- competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples. Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).
