Entry Fees:

International Players

- \$200 USD per player for up to 3 events
- Entry fees must be paid in cash to the organizers before the beginning of the tournament commencement.
- If the entry fees are not paid prior to first match, the players concerned will not be allowed to compete in the tournament and will not be awarded any BWF ranking points.
- The Member Association that enters a player is responsible for paying the entry fee for that player.
- The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not withdrawn by the BWF closing deadline.

Prize Money:

The 2018 Yonex/K&D Graphics International Challenge Prize Money is \$25,000. The prize money will be paid out in US\$.

PLEASE READ: United States income tax withholding laws will apply towards the prize money. The tax rate will be 30% for all foreigners (non-resident alien). If a player from a country can provide documentation of a tax treaty between their country and the United States, their tax withholding will be at a lower rate. For US citizens and permanent residents, a W-4 Form will need to be filled out and completed for amounts \$600 and above to avoid a 28% withholding.

The 2018 Yonex/K&D Graphics International Challenge will be conducted under the conditions as laid down by the Badminton World Federation (BWF) governing BWF International Challenge Events (in the event of dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final). The fixed height service rule (Law 9.1.6.) will be in effect at this tournament Withdrawals: Withdrawal regulations and penalties will be based on BWF Regulations. Betting:	 Betting: "There will be betting on offer from this event. Betting is however not allowed to be made by players or officials connected to the event either in person or through a third party. Participants may therefore not make bets on the Event or procure through third parties the making of bets with a betting agency. Participants who, in violation of this prohibition, nevertheless make or procure through third parties the making of bets with betting agencies shall be immediately disqualified from participation in the Event and are liable for legal prosecution. Similarly manipulation of games will be met with disqualification and possible legal prosecution. Any violation mentioned above is also a breach of Player's Code of Conduct (Art. 5.2.) and will be sanctioned by BWF."
Clothing:	 Color, design, lettering and advertising on players' clothing shall be regulated by General Competition Regulations 20 to 24. For International Challenge tournaments, the name on the back of the shirt is mandatory for all matches in the main draw. It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same color. Opposing teams must wear significantly different colors. In applying General Competition Regulations 20 to 24, the decision of the Referee shall be final.
Practice Facilities:	 Practice times at the venue from Sunday onwards may be requested from the Orange County Badminton Club before the event starts, or by completing the practice request form and emailing to eventsocbc@gmail.com by Friday December 14, 2018 Practice Courts may be available Tuesday and Wednesday morning depending on the match schedules
Transport:	 Airport transportation between the tournament hotel Ayres Hotel Anaheim – Katella) and Los Angeles Airport (LAX) or John Wayne Airport (SNA) will only be provided without charge for players staying at Ayres Hotel Anaheim - Katella Players, coaches, and officials not staying at the tournament hotels may request transportation for a \$40 fee (ONE WAY – from airport to hotel).
