Transportation	<p>The Organizing Committee will offer transportation from <b>J.A. Pengel Airport</b> to the official hotels, however, only those who are staying at the official hotel / apartments can use the transportation.</p> <p><i>Parents, family and companions staying at the official hotel may also use the transportation for a one-time fee of US\$ 30 per person.</i></p> <p>The Organizing Committee will also offer transportation from the official hotel to the venue (only for those staying at the hotel). In this transport, the priority is the players and coaches. If necessary, the family should wait for another transport.</p> <p><b>Transportation services will be offered only in the period from 19 to 22 April 2019</b></p>
