Eligible Players:

U19: Players who are U19 years of age throughout the year 2019 (i.e. born on 2001 or younger) and who are eligible to represent for BWF Member Associations are allowed to play, **BPAC** require player's passports to confirm the age and nationality.

Anti-doping:

Anti-doping will be conducted in accordance with BWF and WADA regulations. Please consult the BWF website for future information, and to view the current WADA Prohibited List. Please note that athletes must complete a TUE application process to apply for authorization to take medications which fall under the Prohibited List – before they take the medication.

Events & Medals

Events: Boys' Singles, Girls' Singles, Boys' Doubles, Girls' Doubles and Mixed Doubles.

Medals: Winner: Gold Medal

Runners up: Silver Medal Losing Semifinalist: Bronze Medal

Entry limits & Competition System:

A Main Draw of 64 for singles and doubles.

Each Member Association can enter the following number of players/pairs per event:

Singles (BS/GS) A maximum of 4 players per event.
 Doubles (BD/GD) A maximum of 2 pairs per event.
 Mixed Doubles A maximum of 4 pairs per event.

According with **BPAC** regulations, host Member Association can enter the following number of players/pairs per event:

Singles (BS/GS) A maximum of 6 players per event.
 Doubles (BD/GD) A maximum of 3 pairs per event.
 Mixed Doubles A maximum of 6 pairs per event.

VISAS:

Important for all players who need visa to Canada:

Please request immediately from Badminton Canada an official Invitation Letter and apply as soon as possible. In order to issue the invitation, you must complete the 2019 Pan Am JR Championship Visa Application Form. Please send the form to the email address below.

Electronic Travel Authority (eTA): If you DO NOT need a VISA to come to Canada, you will s need an eTA. eTAs can be secured upon the purchase of your flight or by going to the following website https://bit.ly/2zLhLcU.

VISA/eTA exemption: Citizens of the USA who are travelling to Canada on their USA passport do not require an eTA or VISA to enter Canada.

Transportation:

Badminton Canada will offer transportation from the airport to the official Hotel, and venue, only when booking reservations with the official Booking Form for the Official Hotels.

Uniforms:

According **BPAC** regulations, for all tournaments the player's name and the country on the back of the shirt is mandatory. (BWF GCR, refereeing player's clothing, designs, advertising and lettering).

Take note that the name of the payer on the back of the shirt must comply with the name registered on BWF – player's data base.
