- The entry deadline for USA players is <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>June 11</u>, <u>2019 11.59PM PST</u>.
- Late Entries will be accepted until <u>Friday</u>, <u>June 14</u>, <u>2019 11.59AM PST</u> with a late penalty fee of \$200.00 (per player or per doubles pair) in accordance with the <u>USAB's International Tournament Entry Procedures</u>, after which no late entries will be accepted.

Entry Fees:

International Players

- \$150 USD per player for 3 events.
- Entry fees must be paid in cash to the organizers before the beginning of the tournament.
- If the entry fees are not paid prior to the first match, the players concerned will not be allowed to compete in the tournament and will not be awarded any BWF ranking points.
- Any Member Association that enters a player is responsible for paying the entry fee for that player.
- The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not withdrawn by the BWF closing deadline.
- The Member Association will be responsible for the player's entry fee for any
 withdrawals after the BWF entry closing date (June 18, 2019) except for
 withdrawals from players who are not in any main or qualifying draw.

USA Players

Prize Money:

The 2019 Silicon Valley International Series Prize Money totals \$10,000USD. The prize money will be paid out in cash US\$.

PLEASE READ: United States income tax withholding laws will apply towards the prize money. The tax rate will be 30% for all foreigners (non-resident alien). If a player from a country can provide documentation of a tax treaty between their country and the United States, their tax withholding will be at a lower rate. For US citizens and permanent residents, a W-4 Form will need to be filled out and completed for amounts \$600 and above to avoid a 28% withholding.

Registration will take place on Tuesday, July 16, 2019 at the Chase Suites Hotel.

Shuttlecock:

- 2019 Silicon Valley International Series will use a BWF certified shuttlecock.
- Practice shuttlecocks will be available at the venue for a minimal cost.

Conditions of Play:

The 2019 Silicon Valley International Series will be conducted under the conditions as laid down by the Badminton World Federation (BWF) governing BWF International Series Events (in the event of a dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final).

Withdrawals:

For International Entries

- Withdrawal without penalty Monday July 1 at 23:59h (GMT +08:00) BWF HQ, Kuala Lumpur Malaysia.
- Withdrawal regulations and penalties are based on BWF Regulations.
- Withdrawals can only be made through the Member Association and before the BWF closing deadline. A BWF Member Association can withdraw through the BWF online entry system.

Betting:	 Betting: "There will be betting on offer from this event. Betting is however not allowed to be made by players or officials connected to the event either in person or through a third party. Participants may therefore not make bets on the Event or procure through third parties the making of bets with a betting agency. Participants who, in violation of this prohibition, nevertheless make or procure through third parties the making of bets with betting agencies shall be immediately disqualified from participation in the Event and are liable for legal prosecution. Similarly, manipulation of games will be met with disqualification and possible legal prosecution. Any violation mentioned above is also a breach of Player's Code of Conduct (Art. 5.2.) and will be sanctioned by BWF." 	
Clothing:	 Color, design, lettering and advertising on players' clothing shall be regulated by General Competition Regulations 19 to 23. For International Series tournaments, the name on the back of the shirt is mandatory for all matches in the main draw. It is mandatory for semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same color. In applying General Competition Regulations 19 to 23, the decision of the Referee shall be final. 	
Practice Facilities:	 Practice times at the venue 7/16-21 may be requested by emailing a completed practice request to the Event Tournament Director, Victor Leung at victor.usab@gmail.com by Tuesday May 28, 2019. Practice Courts may be available On Saturday and Sunday (1PM- 4PM PST). 	
Transport:	 Transportation to/from the San Jose Airport and the Chase Suites Hotel (official hotel) will be provided without charge for players registered there. Players, coaches, and team officials not staying at the tournament hotel may request transportation for a \$40 fee (ONE WAY – from airport to hotel) if you are not able to book a Lyft or Uber on your own. Anti-Doping:	 Random or targeted drug testing may be carried out at any time during the course of the competition. All testing if carried out will be in accordance with the current BWF, World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA), and the United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) regulations.
