	Sunday 30 April - Men's Triples - Women's Triples  <b>The winner of each triples event will obtain one (1) quota place (three athletes) to participate in the 2023 ANOC World Beach Games in Bali.</b>
<b>Team Manager</b>	Each participant Member Association must appoint a Team Manager.

<b>Insurance Coverage</b>	<p>Players and all members of the national delegation shall hold valid insurance for damages of any nature caused to third parties. Such insurance shall cover bodily injury, illnesses including but not limited to positive COVID-19 cases, medical and hospitalisation/quarantine expenses incurred in the host country, and all expenses and costs associated with repatriating the injured/ill party to its country of residence. Please check to make sure you have adequate insurance in place.</p>
<b>Indemnity</b>	<p>To the extent permitted by applicable law, all players and members of the national delegation shall release the BWF, the local partner and their respective officers, officials, employees, agents, and representatives from any and all liability, damage, loss, cost, or expense that such players and members of the national delegation may incur as a result or in connection with their participation to the tournament.</p>

## 2. Entry Details

<b>Entry Fee</b>	No entry fees will be charged to participants.
<b>Entry Deadlines</b>	<p>28 March 2023 (18.00h Lima) - submission of the preliminary list of players</p> <p>28 April 2023 - submission of the final list of players at the Team Managers Meeting</p>
<b>Preliminary List of Players</b>	Countries are allowed to submit a preliminary list of 12 players per gender, from which three or four players will be chosen to participate in the tournament.
<b>Allowed Final Entries per Country</b>	<p>Male Players: minimum 3 and maximum 4.</p> <p>Female Players: minimum 3 and maximum 4.</p>
<b>Entry Process</b>	Member Associations must complete the Team Entry Form and return it to <a href="mailto:events@badmintonpanam.org">events@badmintonpanam.org</a>
<b>Eligibility</b>	Participation in this Continental Qualifier is open to all Member Associations affiliated with Badminton Pan Am and in accordance with BWF General Competition Regulations - Section 6: International Representation.
<b>Mixed Team Relay Ranking for Seeding</b>	04 April 2023 - BWF World Team Ranking
<b>Mixed Team Relay Draw</b>	11 April 2023

<b>Men's and Women's Triples Events Seeding</b>	Based on the Mixed Team Relay Results on Saturday, 29 April.
<b>Men's and Women's Triples Draw</b>	The draw for the Men's and Women's Triples shall be done immediately after the last tie of the Mixed Team Relay event.

<b>Event Rules</b>	<p>The 2023 ANOC World Beach Games - Pan Am Qualification stage will be held as per the current editions of the following documents that are in force at the time of the event:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Mixed Team Relay Rules - <a href="#">link</a></li> <li>- Individual Events Rules (Men's and Women's Triples) - <a href="#">link</a></li> </ul>
<b>Practice Sessions</b>	Practice will be available at the competition venue from Monday to Friday. The practice schedule will be communicated later.
<b>Clothing and Equipment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The AirShuttles used during the AirBadminton Competition will be supplied by the BWF.</li> <li>- The athletes' clothing consists of shorts and shirts.</li> <li>- The Referee may authorise an athlete to play with compression pants or sleeves.</li> <li>- Athletes must play barefoot; however, the Referee may authorise an athlete to play with shoes and/or socks in special circumstances.</li> <li>- Players may wear a hat/head covering, glasses or lenses at their own risk.</li> <li>- Clothing and equipment used by athletes and other participants in the event must comply with the documents listed below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▫ BWF Laws of Badminton - Section 4.</li> <li>▫ BWF General Competition Regulations - Sections 20 to 24.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Presentation Ceremony</b>	All prize ceremonies will take place on Sunday 30 April 2023, immediately after the conclusion of each final. Medals/trophies/others will be presented to all champions and finalists.
<b>AirShuttles</b>	AirShuttles will be provided during practice sessions and the competition.
<b>Medical Services</b>	A medical officer will be available throughout the tournament during hours of play, free of charge to players.
