To participate in a Continental Pan American Championships, the player must hold a passport of a country whose territory the Member Association has jurisdiction over. **BPAC** requires player's passports to confirm the age and nationality.



According to the BPAC Regulations **Associated Members** can enter players to a Continental Events as long as their BWF **BWF ID** is registered under the name of the Associated Member and has been born in the Associated Member Territory. *Players passports printed copies will be presented at the end of the Team Managers Meeting*

Entry limits & Competition system:

A Main Draw of 64 for singles and doubles.

Each Member Association can enter the following number of players/pairs per event:

- Singles (BS/GS) A maximum of four (4) players per event.
- Doubles (BD/GD) A maximum of two (2) pairs per event.
- Mixed Doubles A maximum of four (4) pairs.

According with BPAC Regulations, the **Host Member Association** can enter the following number of players/pairs per event:

- Singles (BS/GS) A maximum of six (6) players per event.
- Doubles (BD/GD) A maximum of three (3) pairs per event.
- Mixed Doubles A maximum of six (6) pairs per event.

1. Players are allowed to play a maximum of three **(3)** events: one (1) singles, one (1) doubles and one (1) mixed only. A player is allowed to play in a higher category if he/she does not play that/those (events) in his/her own category.

Visas

Important for all players who need visa to Peru:

Please request immediately from Badminton Peru an official letter and apply as soon as possible. In order to issue the invitation, you must complete the 2023 Pan Am Junior Championship Visa application form. Please send the form to the email address below.

Transportation:

Badminton Peru will provide **mandatory** transportation from the airport to the official hotels, and daily to tournament venue, for players, team members and entourage which has been **registered at the official hotel through the Organizing Committee.**

Uniforms:

According **BPAC** regulations, for all tournaments the player's name and country name on the back of the shirt is mandatory. (BWF GCR, refereeing player's clothing, designs advertising and lettering). **Take note that the name of the player on the back of the shirt must comply with the name registered on BWF – player's data base.**

Anti - Doping:

Anti-doping will be conducted in accordance with BWF and WADA regulations. Please consult the BWF website for further information, and to view the current WADA Prohibited List. Please note that athletes must complete a TUE application process to apply for authorization to take medications which fall under the Prohibited List – before they take medication.

Doping control

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-ofcompetition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

Badminton Integrity

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).
